RE: Marine Cargo Incident in Hilo Bay

Dear Valued Customer,

We are investigating an incident involving our Honolulu to Hilo barge to determine what caused a number of containers to go overboard in Hilo Bay. No employees were injured in this incident. We are actively working to remediate the situation in coordination with the United States Coast Guard and other Federal and State agencies. A salvage company was secured at daybreak and they immediately began removal of any containers from Hilo Bay. No hazardous materials were discharged into the ocean.

Please rest assured that the sailing schedule between Honolulu and Hilo, as well as our other sailing routes, will continue as usual and without interruption. However, we kindly request your patience and flexibility as cargo availability for this particular Hilo sailing has been impacted. Our team members are working diligently and safely to discharge the cargo from the barge.

We remain committed to moving what matters most to you as safely and as efficiently as possible. We will keep you informed with more details as they become available, and we appreciate your support and understanding.
