# Why a single-island carrier is the most effective solution

A single inter-island regulated carrier, as opposed to having more than one, results in several benefits:


- + keeps costs as low as possible by placing more cargo on each barge – dividing the same amount of cargo between two barges results in higher costs for both barges; and
- + avoids conflicts on the piers and within terminals where space is already constrained.

## Regulated

Young Brothers is regulated by Hawai'i Public Utilities Commission and must obtain approval to raise prices. Competitors are not regulated by the PUC.



## Flexible Solutions

Shipping all sizes = more flexible options for consumers. 20' 40' 45' foot containers, refrigerated and frozen cargo, flat racks and platforms, break bulk, autos, mixed cargo
