



# HILO BARGE ARRIVAL DELAYED

## UPDATE NO. 1

October 1, 2025

Dear Valued Customer,

As previously stated in our last notice, the sailing scheduled to arrive in Hilo on Thursday, October 2, 2025, has been delayed after our barge sustained minor damage while exiting Honolulu harbor. Cargo destined for Hilo will be loaded on another barge that will depart today, and is expected to arrive in Hilo on Friday, October 3, 2025.

For customer convenience, the port will have extended gate hours on Friday, October 3, 2025, until 3:30 p.m., closed for lunch from 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. The port will have special gate hours on Saturday, October 4, 2025, from 7:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. Cargo availability is as follows:

- Dry and Refrigerated Straightload Equipment: Upon discharge
- Refrigerated Loose and Palletized Cargo: Upon notification
- Dry Palletized Cargo: Saturday, October 4, 2025, at 7:30 a.m.
- Automobiles, Roll-on Roll-off, and Dry Mixed Cargo: Saturday, October 4, 2025, at 7:30 a.m.

Cargo from Hilo will be available in Honolulu on Monday, October 6, 2025.

Due to the changes to Tuesday's Honolulu to Hilo sailing, Young Brothers provides the following update on sailings that have been adjusted for the remainder of the week to allow us to send a recovery barge to the Port of Hilo.

Honolulu to Kahului sailing Wednesday, 10/01/25 - **RESCHEDULED**

The barge scheduled to depart from Honolulu to Kahului today, will now depart tomorrow, Thursday, October 2, 2025, and arrive in Kahului on Friday, October 3, 2025. There are no changes to cargo availability or acceptance.

Honolulu to Kahului sailing Thursday, 10/02/25 - **RESCHEDULED**

The barge scheduled to depart on Thursday, will now depart on Friday, October 3, 2025, and arrive in Kahului on Saturday, October 4, 2025. For customer convenience, the port will have special gate hours on Saturday, October 4, 2025, from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., and closed for lunch from 10:45 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Cargo availability is as follows:

- Dry and Refrigerated Straightload Equipment: Upon discharge
- Refrigerated loose and palletized cargo: Saturday, October 4, 2025, from 1:00 p.m. - 2:30 p.m.
- Dry palletized cargo: Monday, October 6, 2025, from 7:30 a.m. - 10:30 a.m.
- Automobiles, Roll-on Roll-off, and Dry Mixed Cargo: Upon notification

There are no changes to cargo acceptance for cargo destined to Honolulu.

As a reminder, Young Brothers will have modified hours of operation at the **Port of Honolulu on Friday, October 3, 2025**, to facilitate a “stop work” meeting held by team members represented by the International Longshore & Warehouse Union Local 142, who have a contractual right to hold bi-monthly meetings to discuss union matters. The port will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Young Brothers do not foresee any additional impacts to future sailings for the remainder of the week, however, capacity to certain ports for the upcoming weeks may be affected until an evaluation can be done on the damages to the barge and its ability to safely transport cargo between the islands.
