



# KAUMALAPAU BARGE ARRIVAL DELAYED for Wednesday, June 3, 2026

Dear Valued Customer,

Due to forecasted unfavorable weather and ocean conditions, Young Brothers' Tuesday Molokai/Lanai combo sailing will depart from Honolulu on Wednesday, June 3, 2026, and will sail directly to the Port of Kaunakakai in time for the regularly scheduled arrival. There will be no changes to cargo availability and gate hours for the Port of Kaunakakai.

After discharging Moloka'i-bound cargo, the barge will then sail to the Port of Kaumalapau and arrive on Thursday, June 4, 2026. Young Brothers will discharge the barge and will have special gate hours until 3:30 p.m. for the pick up of all cargo. The port will continue to accept Honolulu-bound cargo on Tuesday, June 2, 2026, and will operate on modified hours Wednesday, June 3, 2026, from 7:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

The barge is expected to return to Honolulu on Friday, June 5, 2026. Customers expecting cargo from Kaumalapau and Kaunakakai will be notified upon availability.
