



## ADDITIONAL SAILING FOR THE PORT OF KAUMALAPAU Departing Saturday, June 13, 2026

Dear Valued Customer,

As stated in our previous notice, our towing tug underwent repairs that affected scheduled sailings to Kaumalapau and Kaunakakai. We are pleased to share that repairs have been completed and that the tug and barge have arrived in the Port of Kaumalapau.

We recognize the disruption these delays placed on our customers and the communities we serve. To help ensure that all affected cargo reaches its destination as quickly as possible, Young Brothers has scheduled an additional one-time direct sailing to the Port of Kaumalapau that will depart from Honolulu to Kaumalapau on Saturday, June 13, 2026, and arrive in the afternoon. The port of Kaumalapau will have special gate hours on Monday, June 15, 2026, from 7:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Cargo availability is as follows:

- Dry and refrigerated straightload containers: Upon discharge
- Refrigerated loose and palletized cargo: Monday, June 15, 2026, at 7:30 a.m.
- Dry palletized cargo: Monday, June 15, 2026, at 7:30 a.m.
- Automobiles, Roll-on Roll-off, and Dry Mixed Cargo: Upon notification
