Dear Valued Customer,

Since Young Brothers' last update, the storm has continued to bring high winds, heavy rainfall, and severe thunderstorms requiring Young Brothers to make changes to departure and arrival times for certain sailings this week.

Sailing Schedule Update:

Honolulu to Kawaihae sailing Thursday, 01/30/25 - DEPARTED, ETA 01/31/25 7:30 AM

No changes to cargo availability.

Honolulu to Kahului sailing Thursday, 01/30/25 - DELAYED

Weather conditions in Honolulu Harbor continue to deteriorate, in addition harbor conditions at the Port of Kahului are forecasted to deteriorate on Friday, January 31, 2025, as the storm continues to pass the Hawaiian Islands. For the safety of our employees, our vessels, and your cargo, the barge will depart Honolulu on Friday, January 31, 2025, and is expected to arrive in Kahului on Saturday, February 1, 2025, at 7:00 a.m. The port will have special gate hours on Saturday from 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Cargo availability is as follows:

- Dry and refrigerated straightload containers: Upon Discharge
- Refrigerated loose and palletized cargo: Saturday, February 1, 2025, upon notification
- Dry palletized and mixed cargo: Monday, February 3, 2025, at 7:30 a.m.
- Automobiles and Roll-on Roll-off Cargo: Upon Notification

The Port of Kahului will continue to be open tomorrow, Friday, January 31, 2025 from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Honolulu to Nāwiliwili sailing Thursday, 01/30/25 - DELAYED

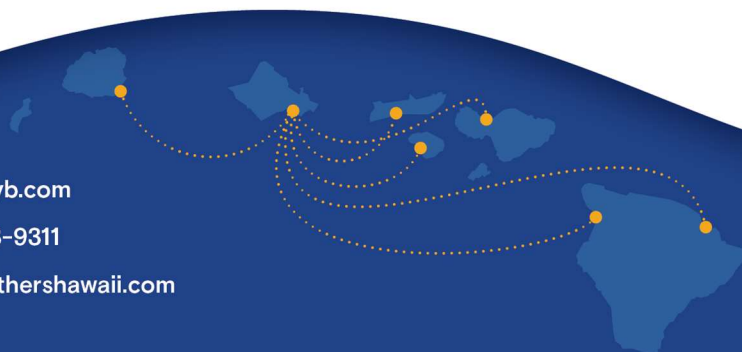
We will provide updated arrival times tomorrow morning.
