Since Young Brothers' last update, please see the updated sailing schedule for the remainder of this week:

Honolulu to Hilo sailing Saturday, August 24, 2024 - RESCHEDULED

- **The barge is now scheduled to depart on Sunday, August 25, 2024, and is estimated to arrive on Tuesday, August 27, 2024.**

Honolulu to Kaunakakai sailing Sunday, August 25, 2024 – NO CHANGES

Honolulu to Kawaihae, Nawiliwili, and Kahului sailing Monday, August 26, 2024 – NO CHANGES

- **All cargo restrictions have been removed. All cargo must be received by the normal cargo cut-off times as posted in YB's [Cargo Acceptance/Availability Information](#).**

Hilo to Honolulu sailing Monday, August 26, 2024 – RESCHEDULED

- The barge is now scheduled to depart on Tuesday, August 28, 2024, and will arrive on Friday, August 30, 2024. There are no changes to cargo acceptance at the Port of Hilo.

Honolulu to Hilo sailing Tuesday, August 27, 2024 – RESCHEDULED

- The barge is now scheduled to depart on Wednesday, August 28, 2024, and will arrive on Friday, August 30, 2024. There are no changes to cargo acceptance at the Port of Honolulu.

Honolulu to Kaunapau/Kaunakakai sailing Tuesday, August 27, 2024 – NO CHANGES

As a precaution, no livestock will be accepted at all ports for the remainder of the week.

Young Brothers will continue monitoring the impacts of Hurricanes Hone and Gilma to weather and ocean conditions and may continue to make adjustments as necessary.
