After review of the current forecast and port status as provided by the United States Coast Guard (USCG) and State of Hawai'i Department of Transportation – Harbors Division (DOT-H), there are no further sailing schedules changes for the remainder of the week and all cargo will be accepted statewide per the [Cargo Acceptance/Availability Information](#) sheet. Livestock shippers are asked to work directly with your local customer service offices to re-book shipments. Outer bands of Kiko may continue to generate severe ocean conditions as it continues to pass north of the state which may delay departure and/or arrival times for the remainder of the week.
