- The barge is scheduled to depart on Tuesday, Sept. 8, 2026, and is estimated to arrive on Wednesday, Sept. 9, 2026.
- The port will be **CLOSED** on Tuesday, Sept. 8, 2026.
- The port will have extended gate hours on Wednesday, Sept. 9, 2026, from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., closed for lunch from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.
