



HURRICANE KIKO UPDATE NO. 3

Dear Valued Customer,

Young Brothers continues to monitor Hurricane Kiko as it continues toward the Hawaiian Islands and provides the following update on sailing schedule and cargo acceptance for the upcoming week based on current weather forecast and port status¹ as provided by the United State Coast Guard (USCG) and State of Hawai'i Department of Transportation – Harbors Division (DOT-H).

Sailing Schedule Updates

Honolulu to Hilo sailing RESCHEDULED to Friday, September 5, 2025 - **ARRIVED**

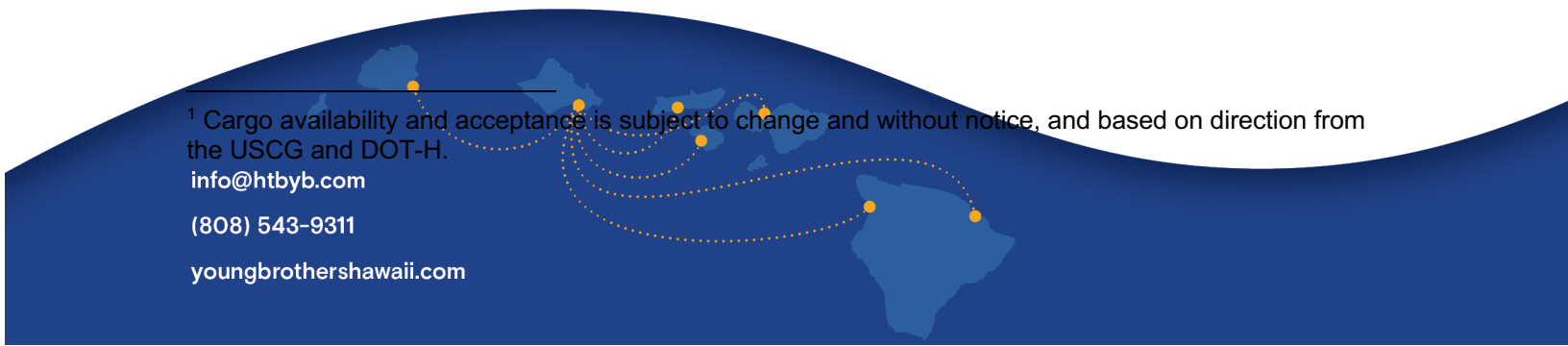
- The barge has arrived safely in port and cargo discharge has begun. Cargo availability¹ is as follows:
 - Dry and Refrigerated Straightload Containers – Upon discharge
 - Refrigerated loose and palletized cargo – Sunday, September 7, 2025, at 8:30 a.m.
 - Dry mixed and palletized cargo – Tuesday, September 9, 2025, at 7:30 a.m.
- The barge will stay overnight in Hilo and is now scheduled to depart on Monday, September 8, 2025.
 - Dry and Refrigerated Straightload containers will be accepted starting at 7:30 a.m. and refrigerated palletized and loose cargo will be accepted starting at 9:30 a.m.
 - **No automobiles, roll-on roll-off cargo or hazardous material cargo (including in straightload containers) will be accepted except for medical/emergency supplies and public safety vehicles.**
 - **Subject to changes in weather forecast.**

Honolulu to Kaunakakai sailing RESCHEDULED to Saturday, September 6, 2025 - **ARRIVED**

- The barge has arrived safely in port and cargo discharge has begun. Cargo availability¹ is as follows:
 - Dry and Refrigerated Straightload Containers – Upon notification
 - Refrigerated loose and palletized cargo – Upon notification
 - Dry mixed and palletized cargo – Tuesday, September 9, 2025, at 8:30 a.m.
- The barge will stay overnight in Kaunakakai and is now scheduled to depart on Monday, September 8, 2025.
 - All cargo will be accepted except for **livestock, automobiles, roll-on roll-off cargo and hazardous material cargo (including in straightload containers)** Exception will be given for medical/emergency supplies and public safety vehicles.
 - **Refrigerated cargo will be accepted on Monday, September 8, 2025 starting at 9:00 a.m. Subject to changes in weather forecast.**

Honolulu to Kawaihae, Nawiliwili, and Kahului sailing Monday, September 8, 2025 – NO CHANGES

¹ Cargo availability and acceptance is subject to change and without notice, and based on direction from the USCG and DOT-H.



Cargo Acceptance and Availability Updates

While Kiko's current forecast is to pass north of the Hawaiian Islands on Tuesday and Wednesday, Young Brothers anticipates swells and winds to peak along and cause severe ocean conditions that may delay departure and arrival times for the remainder of the week. As a reminder, all current cargo restrictions including the restriction of **livestock, automobiles, roll-on roll-off cargo and hazardous material cargo (including in straightload containers) with the exception of medical/emergency supplies and public safety vehicles, will remain in place, until otherwise informed in another notice.**
