

Modified Operations & Sailing Schedule Update

October 17, 2024

Dear Valued Customer,

Due to a mechanical issue with our towing tug, Young Brothers finds it necessary to make changes to our operations and sailing schedule for the remainder of this week for our facilities at the Ports of Hilo and Nāwiliwili.

Port of Hilo

Our barge, the Kukahi, which was originally scheduled to depart the Port of Hilo today, Thursday, October 17, 2024, will now depart on Friday, October 18, 2024 and arrive in Honolulu on Sunday, October 20, 2024. There are no changes to cargo acceptance or gate hours at the Port of Hilo today or tomorrow, Friday, October 18, 2024. Cargo will be available in Honolulu on Monday, October 21, 2024.

Port of Nawiliwili

Our barge, the *Ho`omaka Hou*, which was scheduled to arrive in Nāwiliwili on Friday, October 18 will now arrive in Nāwiliwili on Saturday, October 19, 2024.

For customer convenience, the port will have special gate hours on Saturday, October 19, 2024, from 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m (closed for lunch from 11:00 a.m. to Noon). Cargo availability is as follows:

- Dry and refrigerated straightload containers: Saturday, October 19, 2024, upon discharge.
- Refrigerated loose and palletized cargo: Saturday, October 19, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.
- Dry palletized cargo: Monday, October 21, 2024, at 7:30 a.m.
- Automobiles, Roll-on Roll-off, and Dry Mixed Cargo: Upon notification

The port will be open on Friday, October 18, 2024, from 7:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and there are no changes to cargo acceptance at the port of Nāwiliwili for cargo destined to Honolulu. All empty container returns must be received on Friday by 11:30 a.m.
