Lānaʻi Senior Center Receives Gift Donations from Young Brothers

Annual Employee Drive Delivers Eight Boxes of Goods to Community Members

Lanaʻi City, LANAʻI – Yesterday, gift bags of household goods, courtesy of [Young Brothers, Limited](#), were gifted to seniors at the Lānaʻi Community Senior Citizen Lunch, an annual all-ages event honoring Lānaʻi kupuna.

Held on Christmas Day every year, the luncheon provides Lānaʻi's community members in their golden years with a hot meal, gift bags and fellowship during the holidays. Hosted by the churches of Lanaʻi and supported by Young Brothers and other local organizations, contributors donate time, gifts and food to bring Christmas cheer to seniors in need.

“We feel a deep sense of gratitude and connection to the communities we serve throughout the year,” said Chris Martin, Director of Terminal Operations. “The Lānaʻi Community Senior Citizen Lunch is an opportunity for us to share the holiday spirit and share appreciation for an extension of our ‘ohana.”

Participating each year, Young Brothers' employees organize the drive to collect household items, such as blankets, dish towels, cleaning supplies, even socks and crossword puzzles, which Young Brothers then special delivers to the center on Lānaʻi. Community volunteers gift wrap the goods and distribute them to seniors attending the lunch on Christmas Day. Homebound seniors receive their gifts and lunch via the center's home delivery service.
