RE: Emergency and Temporary Operational Changes at the Port of Kaumalapau due to COVID-19 – Tuesday, November 17, 2020 Update

Dear Valued Customer:

All previously implemented emergency and temporary cargo acceptance modifications at the Port of Kaumalapau will continue to remain in effect *through November 30*, consistent with the Mayor's "Safer-at-Home" order.

Specifically, cargo operations for Wednesday's barge arrival at the Port of Kaumalapau will continue to be limited to the drop off and pickup of only dry and refrigerated straightload containers and refrigerated loose cargo. All other cargo arriving on Wednesday's barge including automobiles, roll-on roll-off equipment, and dry mixed and palletized less than container load cargo will continue to be available on Thursday from 7:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

As the County continues to monitor the situation, Young Brothers will provide updates and/or changes as necessary. There will be no changes to our weekly sailing schedule to Lāna'i. Young Brothers would like to remind all customers that all previously stated COVID-19 health and safety guidelines while conducting business at the port remain in place. This includes, among other things, limiting the number of people in your vehicle, wearing a facemask or covering and practicing social distancing especially when interacting with our employees.

Our top priority at Young Brothers is ensuring the safety of our employees, customers, and the communities we serve across Hawai'i. Mahalo for you kōkua, as we all do our part to stop the spread of COVID-19 in Hawai'i.
