



OPERATIONAL UPDATES: TROPICAL STORM NOLO

Sept. 24, 2026

Dear Valued Customer,

Young Brothers is closely monitoring Tropical Storm Nolo in coordination with the United States Coast Guard (USCG) and Department of Transportation Harbors Division (DOT-H). The storm is forecasted to strengthen into a major hurricane today. Accordingly, YB will adjust its sailing schedule and cargo acceptance to mitigate potential impacts. YB will continue to provide updates on its operations as they become available.

Cargo Acceptance

In anticipation of severe ocean conditions and tropical storm force winds, Young Brothers will modify cargo acceptance:

- For sailings from Honolulu to Nāwiliwili and Kahului on Thursday, Sept. 24, 2026, all straightload refrigerated and hazardous cargo will be accepted. **NO** livestock, or less than container load hazardous cargo will be accepted.
- **NO** livestock, less than container load refrigerated cargo, or less than container load hazardous cargo will be accepted in **Honolulu, Hilo, Kawaihae, or Kahului** for the rest of the week for all other sailings.

Sailing Schedule Updates

Hilo to Honolulu sailing Thursday, Sept. 24, 2026

- The port of Hilo will not be accepting any cargo.
- The port is **CLOSED** on Friday, Sept. 25, 2026, as determined by the United States Coast Guard (USCG).

Honolulu to Kawaihae sailing Thursday, Sept. 24, 2026 – **CANCELLED**

- The port is expected to operate normal gate hours on Thursday, Sept. 24, 2026, for the acceptance of cargo.
- The port is **CLOSED** on Friday, Sept. 25, 2026, as determined by the United States Coast Guard (USCG).
- The next expected sailing to Kawaihae is our regularly scheduled sailing on Monday, Sept. 28, 2026.

Honolulu to Kahului sailing Thursday, Sept. 24, 2026 – **NO CHANGES**

- The barge is expected to arrive in Kahului on Thursday, Sept. 24, 2026, for the discharge of all cargo.
- The port will operate normal gate hours on Friday, Sept. 25, 2026, for the pickup of cargo.

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Honolulu to Hilo sailing Saturday, Sept. 26, 2026 - **RESCHEDULED**

- The barge is now scheduled to depart on Sunday, Sept. 27, 2026, and is estimated to arrive on Tuesday, Sept. 29, 2026.
- All dry and refrigerated straightload containers, and mixed cargo destined for Hilo must be received in Honolulu by 3:00 p.m. on Friday, Sept. 25, 2026.
- Cargo from Hilo to Honolulu will be available upon notification.
