Young Brothers is closely monitoring Tropical Storm Nolo in coordination with government and relevant state agencies. The storm is forecasted to strengthen into a major hurricane over the next few days. Accordingly, YB is expecting operational changes and will be adjusting its sailing schedule and gate times to mitigate these effects. YB will continue to provide updates on its operations as they become available.

Sailing Schedule Updates

Honolulu to Kawaihae sailing Thursday, Sept. 24, 2026 – **CANCELLED**

- The port is expected to operate normal gate hours on Thursday, Sept. 24, 2026, for the acceptance of all cargo.
- The port is expected to be **CLOSED** on Friday, Sept. 25, 2026, as determined by the United States Coast Guard (USCG).

Please note that all sailing schedules remain subject to change based on USCG and DOT-H decisions regarding harbor access, restrictions, reopening status, and safe operating conditions. We appreciate your patience and understanding as we operate safely and in coordination with the appropriate federal and state agencies.
