Dear Valued Customer,

Safety remains Young Brothers' top priority following Hurricane Lowell. Young Brothers is coordinating with the Department of Transportation Harbors Division (DOT-H) as statewide port operations return to normal. Cargo acceptance, cargo availability and sailing schedules are operating normally at all ports, with additional port specific considerations noted below:

### Port of Nāwiliwili

The Port of Nāwiliwili is operating normal gate hours, and cargo acceptance and availability. However, YB will continue to prioritize storm relief cargo to support the movement of critical supplies for all upcoming sailings.

### Port of Kaumalapau

YB continues to work closely with DOT-H regarding repairs at the Port of Kaumalapau. We are operating as regularly scheduled and will provide updates of any changes to sailing schedules or operations as information becomes available. Cargo destined for Kaumalapau will be accepted at all ports.
