The United States Coast Guard (USCG) and State of Hawai'i Department of Transportation – Harbors Division (DOT-H) have cleared and **opened all ports**. All open ports will operate normal gate hours for Monday, Aug. 17, 2026.

Sailing Schedule and Cargo Acceptance/Availability Updates

Kahului and Nāwiliwili to Honolulu sailing Friday, Aug. 14, 2026

- Cargo from Kahului to Honolulu will be available upon notification.
- Cargo from Nāwiliwili to Honolulu will be available for pickup in Honolulu on Tuesday, Aug. 18, 2026.

Honolulu to Hilo sailing Saturday, Aug. 15, 2026, - **NO CHANGES**

Honolulu to Kaunakakai sailing Sunday, Aug. 16, 2026 - **CANCELLED**

- The next sailing to the port of Kaunakakai will be our regularly scheduled sailing departing Honolulu on Wednesday, Aug. 19, 2026, and arriving on Thursday, Aug. 20, 2026.
- The port will have gate hours for Monday, Aug. 16, 2026, from 7:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. for the acceptance of all cargo.

Honolulu to Kawaihae, Nāwiliwili, Kahului, sailing Monday, Aug. 17, 2026 - **DELAYED**

- Due to harbor traffic, sailings to Kawaihae, Nāwiliwili, and Kahului, are all expected to be delayed. Updates will be provided as they become available.
- The port of Honolulu will be open on Monday, Aug. 17, 2026. for acceptance of all cargo for these sailings.
