RE: Emergency and Temporary Operational Changes at the Port of Kaunalapau due to COVID-19 – Tuesday, November 3, 2020 Update

Dear Valued Customer:

As the Island of Lanai enters the second week of the Mayor Victorino’s “stay-at-home” order, consistent with the Mayor’s order and due to the number of positive COVID-19 cases on island, Young Brothers’ previously implemented emergency and temporary cargo acceptance modifications will remain in effect for the Port of Kaunalapau.

Specifically, cargo operations for Wednesday’s barge arrival at the Port of Kaunalapau will continue to be limited to the drop off and pickup of only dry and refrigerated straightload containers and refrigerated loose cargo. All other cargo arriving on Wednesday’s barge including automobiles, roll-on roll-off equipment, and dry mixed and palletized less than container load cargo will continue to be available on Thursday from 7:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. We are monitoring the situation closely and will provide updates and/or changes as necessary.

There will be no changes to our weekly sailing schedule to Lānaʻi. Young Brothers would like to remind all customers that all previously stated COVID-19 health and safety guidelines while conducting business at the port remain in place. This includes, among other things, limiting the number of people in your vehicle, wearing a facemask or covering and practicing social distancing especially when interacting with our employees.

Our top priority at Young Brothers is ensuring the safety of our employees, customers, and the communities we serve across Hawaiʻi. Mahalo for you kōkua, as we all do our part to stop the spread of COVID-19 in Hawaiʻi.
