Re: Port of Honolulu Concrete Repair Project

Dear Valued Customer,

This is to inform you that starting Monday, November 30, 2020, the Hawai'i State Department of Transportation, Harbors Division, will begin concrete repair work fronting the area between Pier 39 and the refrigerated cargo holding area known as the "Ice House". We anticipate that the repair work will continue through the month of December.

To facilitate construction and ensure the safety of all involved, there will be a modified traffic pattern between the Nimitz Gate and Pier 39 through the area. Attached is a map highlighting the construction site for your convenience. There are no changes to any container operations in the area.

A few safety reminders for our customers during this repair work:

- Yield to heavy construction equipment and use extreme caution when in the area
- Obey all traffic signs and adhere to the 15 mph speed limit
- Do not use your cell phone when driving on the pier
- Wear high visibility/safety vest and covered toe shoes when outside of your vehicle

Our security personnel will be directing traffic and are able to assist you with any questions. As a reminder, all previously communicated COVID-19 safety protocols are still in place, including wearing face masks while conducting business on the pier. We thank you for your cooperation and patience during this period.
