

As Hawai'i's foremost interisland freight handling company, it is our Ho'ohiki (commitment) to safely transport what matters most to Hawai'i. We do it quickly, reliably, safely, and securely. As a reminder, shipments containing hazardous materials or dangerous articles (hereafter, together referred to as "hazardous cargo") will only be accepted for transportation when certifications, as required by law in the United States Code of Federal Regulations - 49 C.F.R. § 172.204 (Shipper's certification), are properly submitted with the Bill of Lading and/or booking number.

- A. If a shipment has been accepted by Young Brothers, LLC ("YB") for transportation and then an error is found in the required certification, packaging, or other lawful requirements, all damages, penalties, or fines will be charged to the shipper or party required to fulfil such requirements.
- B. When hazardous cargo is required by law to be separated from its original container to ensure safe movement on YB's vessel, such cargo will be considered a separate shipment and will be rated accordingly, and appropriate handling charges to separate the cargo will also be charged.
- C. Transportation of explosives, flammables, and/or corrosive material, compressed gasses, combustible liquids, and other hazardous cargo will be governed by the following regulations, as applicable:

United States Code of Federal Regulations, 49 C.F.R. Parts 100 to 199.

- D. YB will reject any hazardous cargo or hazardous waste that does not meet the Federal requirement for proper shipping papers, labeling or placarding, and packaging. Any additional expenses, fines, or penalties for compliance with Federal regulations will be charged to the shipper.
