

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING
YOUNG BROTHERS
HAZARDOUS MATERIALS SHIPPING CERTIFICATION

- A. SHIPPER:** A person or agent who ships goods by any carrier – Clearly print or type the shipper’s name, address, phone number, fax number, and bill of lading number.
- B. CONSIGNEE:** A person, agent, or dealer to whom goods are delivered to – Clearly print or type the consignee’s name, address, phone number, fax number, and shipping date.
- C. 24-HOUR EMERGENCY CONTACT:** Hazardous Materials Shipping Certificate must contain an emergency response telephone number including the area code or international access code, Person’s Name or Contract Number, for use in the event of an emergency involving the hazardous material, see 49 CFR 172.600.
- D.** Provide number and type of packages being shipped, see 49 CFR 172.202(a)(7)
- E.** Provide the ID Number (UN or NA), see 49 CFR 172.101
- F.** Provide the proper shipping name, see 49 CFR 172.101
- G.** Provide the Hazard Class, see 49 CFR 172.101
- H.** Provide the Packing Group, if applicable, see 49 CFR 172.101
- I.** Provide the Label(s) required, see 49 CFR 172.400
- J.** Gross Weight of cargo must include an indication of the applicable unit of measurement, for example, “200 kgs” or “50 lbs”, see 49 CFR 172.202 (a)(5)
- K.** The Hazardous Materials Shipping Certification must be legibly signed by a principal, officer, partner, or employee of the shipper or his agent and may be legibly signed manually, by typewriter, or by other mechanical means. see 49 CFR 172.204 (d)
