Hawaiian legend about the Ka'ie'ie Waho Channel recites the mo'olelo of Maui, the demi-god of the sun. While standing on the shoreline of O'ahu, Maui cast his great magic fish hook across the channel onto Kaua'i. Gripping his line made of 'ie'ie root, Maui pulled the line so tight that he lost grip of the island and unknowingly snagged only a section of the island which was dragged along the channel floor to the coast of O'ahu. The Kāneana cave at Mākua on the west coast of O'ahu frames a view of the Ka'ie'ie Waho Channel in the distance.
