The Kalohi Channel is the 9.2 mile body of water between Lānaʻi and Molokaʻi. Despite the rough conditions of this small channel, Kalohi translates to “the slowness.” Stacked rocks at Keahiakawelo on Lānaʻi, also known as “Garden of the Gods,” and the island of Molokaʻi in the distance frame the Kalohi channel.
