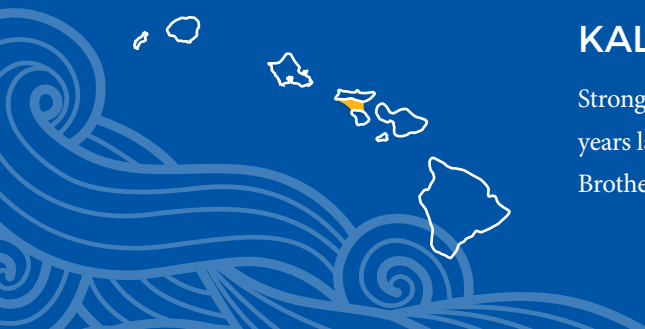




KALOHI CHANNEL

Strong winds and choppy seas are common in the small Kalohi Channel. In 1824, a British vessel, the Alderman Wood, sank off Lānaʻi's north shore. Two years later, the London was purposely grounded there and the ship's hull can still be seen resting on what's known today as Shipwreck Beach. Here, the Young Brothers barge carefully makes its way along the western tip of Molokaʻi.
